### **BROTHER STAN SOBCZYK, F.S.C UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT**



Brother Stanislaus Sobczyk became the 20th President of Christian Brothers University in June 1999, returning to familiar territory since he had already served as Interim President of CBU in 1993-94. Brother Stan currently serves on the Board of Trustees for De La Salle School at Blessed Sacrament, the National Conference for Community and Justice (NCCJ), and St. Mary's University of Minnesota. He was knighted in 2000 by the Knights of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem. Previous positions include Assistant to the President and Coordinator of Catholic Education at St. Mary's College of California and Director of the Stritch Retreat Center on the CBU campus. Brother Stan has taught students from elementary school through doctoral level. He received a Bachelor of Science degree from Christian Brothers University in 1966, a Master of Arts degree from St. Louis University, a Master of Education degree from the University of Memphis, and his doctorate from the University of San Francisco. Brother Stan has been a Brother of the Christian Schools since 1963.

# New Lady Buc squad faces tough schedule

Last year, CBU earned seventeen wins and a fourth-straight Gulf South Conference Championship. The Christian Brothers University Lady Buccaneer's have been the envy of the GSC for the past four years, capturing an NCAA Division II National Championship in 2002, a runner-up finish in 2001 and hosting the NCAA South Region Tournament last season.

With arguably the toughest schedule the team has ever faced, the 2004 Lady Bucs will look to continue their success streak and are matching up against some of the country's top talent in women's soccer.

Five of the first six matches this season will be played against nationally ranked opponents including West Florida at home and the University of Tampa on the road. The Lady Bucs will play seven of the nation's top 25 teams in the first 10 matches of the season.

**GOALKEEPER:** Sophomore **Amy Clunie** will be the starter in goal this year. Clunie is a transfer from the University of Memphis where in six matches last season she had a 1-1-3 record allowing just six goals for an average of 1.06 per game. She had a save percentage of .786 and recorded two shutouts.

**BACKFIELD:** Senior **Kristen Killough** and sophomore **Jo Welsh** return as starters for the on defense this year. Killough had her best offensive season to date scoring five goals and adding eight assists for 18 points on the year. Welsh had three assists last season and helped lead on of the nation's premier defenses. Junior **Ella Thorsteinsdottir** used last year as a red-shirt season after transferring from Division I Richmond. She was a member of the

Atlantic-10 All-Rookie team her freshman year where she was named pre-season All-Conference and had started in 13 of 16 matches.

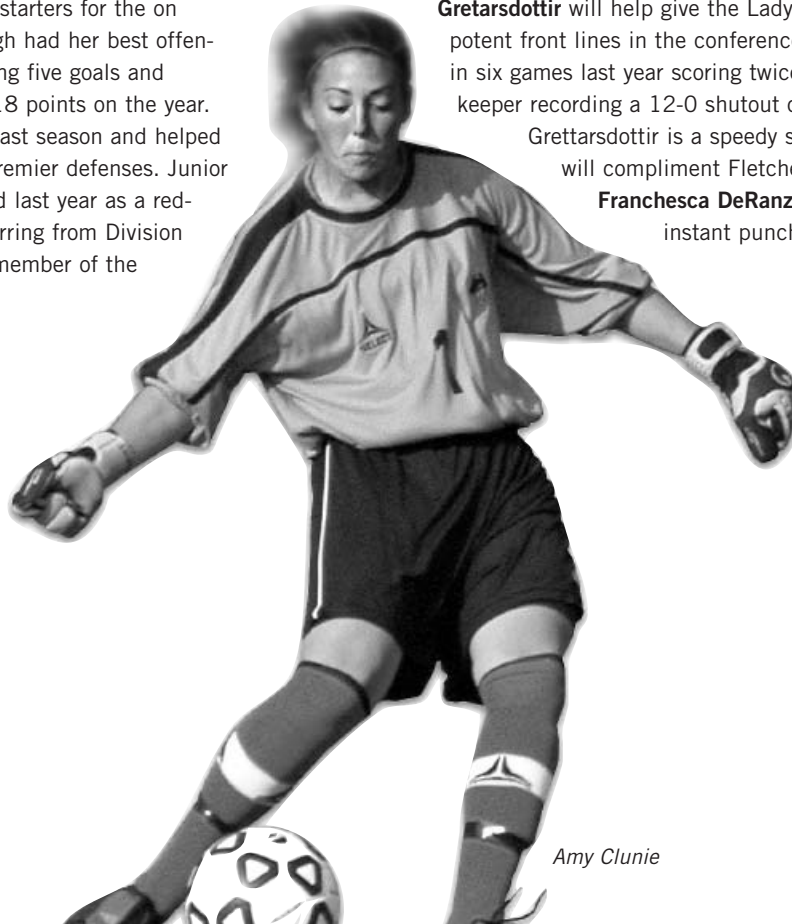
Junior **Angela Papachristou** returns to the team after sitting out last season with a knee injury. Junior **Joanne Tobin** leads a list of new defenders for the Lady Bucs. She will be a starter in the backfield while freshmen **Brittany Butler** and **Stephanie Morgan** should see solid time off the bench.

**MIDFIELD:** Sophomore **Cara O'Hern** is the lone returning starter in the Midfield for the. She scored one goal and had two assists last season for four points playing in all 20 matches, starting the final 13. Junior transfers **Helen Goodacre** and **Ciara McGuinness**, along with freshman **Colleen Hart** will all start for this season. Junior **Ashley Smith** and freshman **Rachael Valenzuela** will see time off the bench and will fight for starting spots. Smith played in one match last season assisting on one goal.

**FORWARDS:** Senior forward **Stacy-Jo Fletcher** leads a talented group of forwards this season. Fletcher started all 20 matches in 2003, scoring 17 goals and leading the GSC in assists with 18 for a total of 52 points on the year.

Sophomore **Jessica Manting** and junior transfer **Embla Gretarsdottir** will help give the Lady Bucs one of the most potent front lines in the conference. Manting saw action in six games last year scoring twice and filled in at goalkeeper recording a 12-0 shutout of Ouachita Baptist.

Gretarsdottir is a speedy scorer from Iceland and will compliment Fletcher nicely. Freshman **Francesca DeRanzo** should provide an instant punch off the bench.

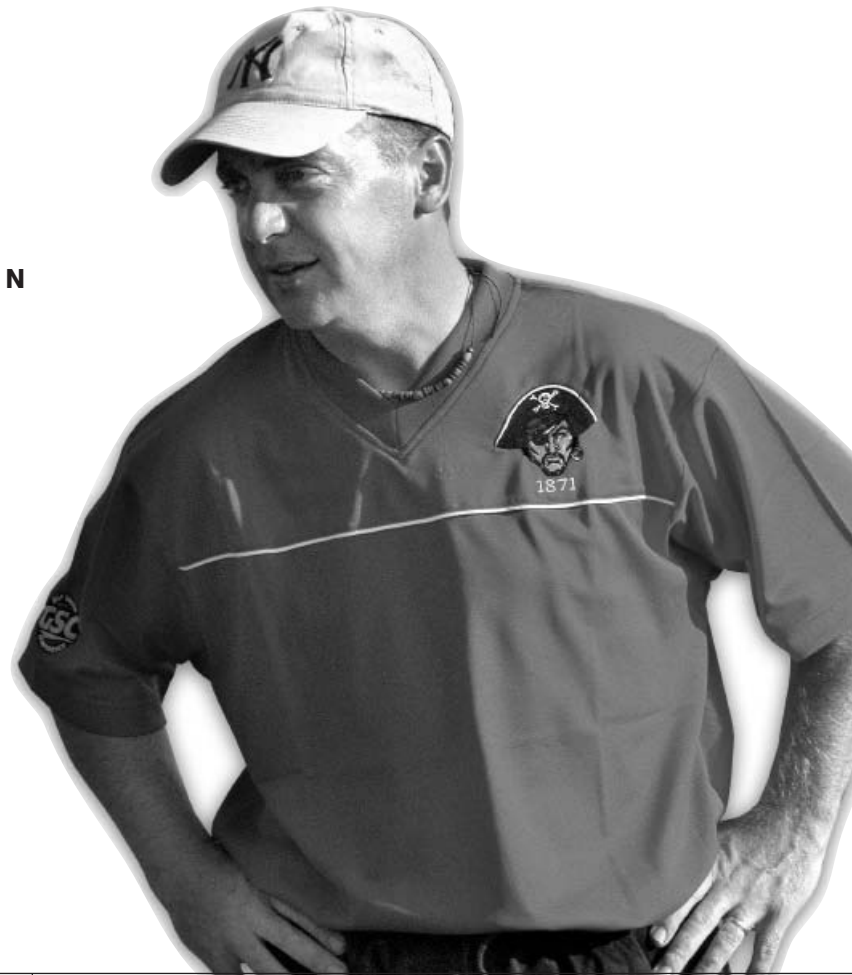

# Seamus Loftus

HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON

Seamus Loftus starts his first full season as head coach of the CBU women's soccer team. Last season, he stepped in after the beginning of the season and led the team to a 17-1-2 record, claiming the program's fourth-straight Gulf South Conference Women's Soccer Championship and a trip to the Finals of the NCAA Division II South Region Tournament. The team finished the season ranked ninth nationally.



# Mark McKeever

ASSISTANT COACH • SECOND SEASON



Mark McKeever begins his second season as an assistant coach after a standout career for the Bucs culminating in a Gulf South Conference Player of the Year award in 2000.

McKeever was a Junior College First-Team All-American twice and a two-time All-South Region selection. He was his team's leading scorer both seasons and an All-Tournament selection.

While at CBU, McKeever was an All-Conference forward and a team captain. He helped lead the Bucs to a conference championship in 2000. That season, McKeever was All-Conference, a Second Team All-South Region selection, and a member of the GSC All-Tournament team, while leading an offense that was first in the league in shots, points, goals and assists.

A native of Glasgow, Scotland, McKeever graduated from CBU with a degree in psychology and is currently pursuing a master's degree at the university.

# Jennifer Kett

GOALKEEPER COACH • FIRST SEASON



Jennifer Kett returns to the Lady Bucs after capping a two-year career for CBU. The Dublin, Ireland native started all but one match last season recording a 16-1-1 record including eight shutouts and a .66 goals against average. The .66 GAA is the sixth-best mark ever in the Gulf South Conference.

Kett owns two GSC records setting the mark for minutes in a season with 1,784 last season. Her career GAA of .58 is also the best-ever in the league. Kett was the GSC Defender of the Week twice last season and was a member of the GSC Academic Honor Roll each year at the school.

She will work primarily with the goalkeepers this season as she finishes her M.B.A. at CBU.

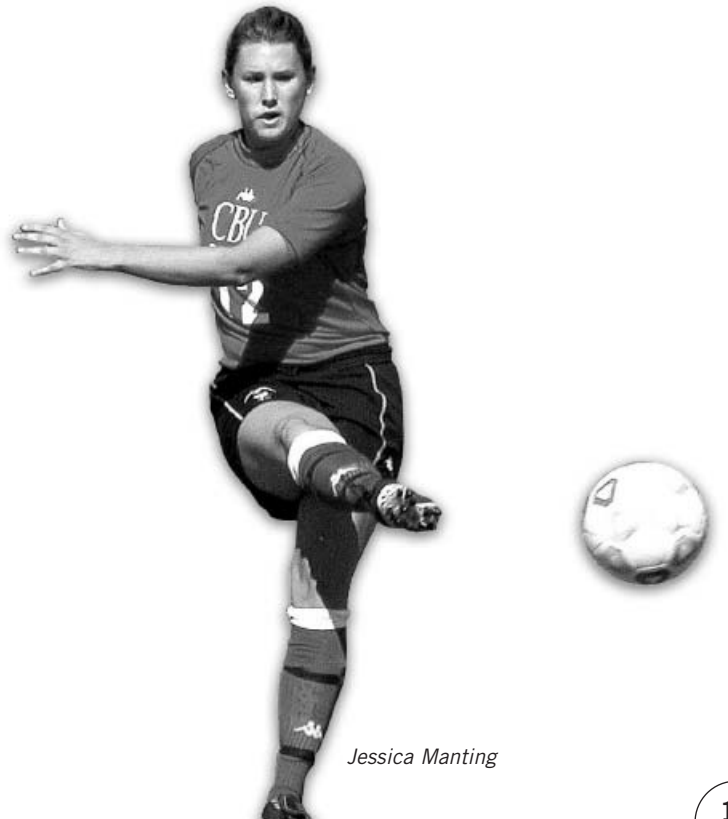

# The Gulf South Conference

The GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE (GSC) enters its 34th year of excellence, continuing a tradition of growth and success that has brought it distinction as one of the elite NCAA Division II conferences. With 17 universities in six southeastern states, the GSC is the largest playing Conference in Division II.



GSC members feature comprehensive athletic programs that compete for 13 official conference championships: football, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, men's and women's basketball, baseball, softball, men's and women's tennis and men's golf. In 2003 and 2004, the GSC conducted a provisional championship in women's golf.

We take pride in our 38 National Team Championships in 12 sports and the emphasis on academic success by our coaches and student-athletes. The 2003-04 season was a banner campaign for the GSC, which claimed its first-ever National Championships in Women's Volleyball (North Alabama) and Men's Tennis (West Florida) and added its fifth Baseball crown behind Delta State's first-ever Title.

Originally known as the Mid-South Conference, the GSC was formed by six universities in the summer of 1970: Delta State, Florence State (now North Alabama), Jacksonville State, Livingston (now West Alabama), Tennessee-Martin and Troy State. Due to scheduling problems during the 1970-71 academic year, the only league sport was football. Jacksonville State won the league's first championship.

In 1971, the league changed its name to the GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE, added Southeastern Louisiana (SELA) and Nicholls State (increasing the membership to eight), and opened an office in Hammond, LA. The following year, Mississippi College and Northwestern Louisiana (NWLA, now Northwestern State) were admitted. NELA withdrew to go Division I two years later, followed by SELA and Nicholls State in 1979.

The conference continued with seven

teams until 1981, when the presidents admitted Valdosta State. West Georgia joined in 1983. Eight years of stability ended in 1991 when Tennessee-Martin and Troy State went Division I, briefly dropping the GSC back to seven members, before the beginning of an expansion resulting in ten new members: Lincoln Memorial University (1992-93); University of Alabama-Huntsville, Henderson State University, University of Central Arkansas and Mississippi University for Women (1993-94); University of West Florida (1994-95); and University of Arkansas-Monticello, Arkansas Tech University, University of Montevallo and Southern Arkansas University (1995-96). Jacksonville State went Division I at the end of 1992-93. Mississippi College dropped to Division III at the end of 1995-96, and was replaced by Christian Brothers University to keep the Conference at 16 schools. In July 2000, the GSC welcomed Harding University and Ouachita Baptist University, making it the largest NCAA conference at any level with 18 schools. The conference membership decreased to 17 when MUW dropped its athletics program at the end of the 2002-03 season.

Former commissioner Jim McCullough moved the GSC office to its present Birmingham location. The current commissioner, Nathan (Nate) N. Salant, has been in office since October 1992. He is assisted by Sports Information Director Michael Anderson, Assistant Sports Information Director Tim Andrzejewski, Office Manager Mary Jean Box and Assistant to the Commissioner Andrea Nguyen. The Chairman of the GSC Board of Directors is Dr. Robert McChesney of the University of Montevallo. Joining him on the executive committee are past-Chair Dr. Robert Brown (Arkansas Tech University) and Vice Chair Dr. Andy Westmoreland (Ouachita Baptist University). The Supervisors of

Officials are Bill Johnson (Football), Mike Murphy (Basketball-East Division) and John Caldwell (Basketball-West Division).
