Fourth Season



In-Sik Hwang enters his fourth season as the coach of the Lady Buccaneers, after leading last year's team to an 18-11 mark and a trip to the first round of the Gulf South

championship. Junior hitter Nan Kimbrell and sophomore blocker Laura Washington were first-team All-GSC for the Western Division.

Hwang arrived at CBU in 2002 with more than 10 years coaching experience on the collegiate, club and high school levels. He graduated with a B.S. in physical education in 1998 from Middle Tennessee State University. He served as an assistant volleyball coach (1993-1996) and as an instructor at MTSU (1995-1996).

Hwang was also an instructor with the Music City Volleyball Club in Nashville (1994) and the Nashville Volleyball Club (1991-1993). His Spike Volleyball Club won the Southern Region District Championship from 1995 to 1998.

Hwang is a member of USA Volleyball and the American Volleyball Coaches Association and is licensed by the USA Coaching Accreditation Program, certified both Level I and II. He has also been Leader level certified in the American Coaching Effectiveness Program.
