Duties of the Election Commission

- Responsible for publicizing the date when candidate applications for both the Executive Council and Senate will be available to interested students.
- The Election Commission determines the deadline for candidate applications.
- After the deadline for candidate applications, the Election Commission is responsible for reviewing each application to determine the list of qualified candidates. Each student who submitted an application shall then be contacted via e-mail about the approval/disapproval of his/her candidacy and the date, time, and location of the mandatory candidate meeting. The list of qualified candidates shall be publicized via the CBU Connection, the Office of Student Life, and other publicity outlets.
- The Election Commission shall hold a meeting for all qualified candidates two days after candidate applications are due. In this meeting campaign policies and procedures should be reviewed in detail.
- The Election Commission shall publicize the dates, times, and places that the election shall be held via the CBU Connection, bulletin board flyers, Thomas Center banners, the CBU web portal, mass campus e-mail, Facebook, and all other possible publicity outlets on campus in order to reach the maximum amount of student voters. Publicity shall begin at least two weeks before the opening of the polls and continue until all polls are closed.
- The Election Commission has the responsibility to report campaign violations to the SGA President, Director of Student Activities, and the Dean of Students.
